

KOS-KALYMNOS FERRY TIMETABLE | November 1st – December 31st 2015

Ferries between Kos and Kalymnos run year-round. There are anywhere between 5-8 crossings per day, every day, depending on season.

The ferries stop running only in the rare case of very severe winds.

There is a fast ferry (25 min; www.anekalymnou.gr) and a slow ferry (45-50 min; www.anemferries.gr). The timetable above includes both. The slow ferry is marked with "SF" and it also transports cars. Prices per person are approx. €6-7 each way. In Kalymnos, both ferries arrive/depart at the main port in Pothia. In Kos, both ferries arrive/depart at Mastichari port, a secondary port not far from the Kos airport (approx. 4 km).
