**FERRY BETA** (most of your questions answered. Please read!)

- Kos–Kalymnos ferries run year-round. There are between 5-10 crossings every day depending on the season. The ferries stop only in the rare case of very severe winds.

- There are two ferries: a fast ferry and a slow ferry. The slow ferry also takes cars. This timetable includes both.

- Tickets are sold at the port. (Kalymnos: Pothia port // Kos: Mastichari port.) There are kiosks at the port near the ferries. If the next scheduled ferry is the fast ferry, the ANEK kiosk will open about 20 minutes before departure and issue the tickets. Similarly, if the next ferry is the slow ferry, the ANEM kiosk will open. Last we checked (Oct 2018) tickets cost around 7 euros per person one-way.

- The last ferry from Kos tries to accommodate passengers arriving on the last flights of the day into Kos.

- We are not affiliated in any way with the ferry companies and we have no control over their frequent timetable changes. We try our best to stay up-to-date with the timetables, but it isn't always possible to keep up. Sorry!
